### **RASMUSSEN COLLEGE ANNOUNCES SECOND ROUND OF 110-YEAR ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS**

*Mandan Resident Paul Riely Receives \$10,000 Academic Scholarship to Apply Toward

**BISMARCK, N.D. (August 25, 2010)** – Local resident Paul Riely has been named a recipient of the Rasmussen College 110-Year Anniversary Scholarship. An initial group of 25 scholarship recipients was announced on May 2010. Riely is one of 34 scholarship recipients named in a second announcement. The \$10,000 scholarship will benefit his completion of a Bachelor's in Business Management degree program through Rasmussen College in Bismarck. The Scholarship Selection Committee chose Riely from nearly 1,300 applicants across the country.
